

Continuing Education Credit Information for Live Webcasts of ALI-ABA's Multi-day Courses of Study

The maximum number of general or self study credit hours approved or recommended for approval in the various states with Mandatory Continuing Legal Education requirements vary from state to state. Information on the number of credits available for the course you participate in will be available with your course materials.

Your attendance at the seminar will be monitored electronically through your assigned "username."

IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. You must respond to **on-screen prompts** throughout the program if licensed to practice in **AZ, KS, NC, NY, OH, RI** or are requesting **CPE credit**.
 2. **A number of states limit the credits allowed for live webcasts.** Refer to the MCLE instructions and information for your state below for more information.
- ❖ To receive your Attendance Certificate, at the end of the webcast or when you close your viewing screen, you **must** complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey.
 - ❖ Print and save your Attendance Certificate. A link is provided on the webcast home page upon completion of the survey.

An asterisk * below indicates that bar members must take special steps for ALI-ABA to report their attendance for MCLE credit and pay any applicable reporting fees.

State	MCLE Information and Instructions
*Alabama	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Limited to 6 credit hours per compliance period.
Arizona	To receive credit, you must answer the on-screen prompts throughout the program and complete the MCLE Request Form when you log-off. Retain your attendance certificate and the written materials to substantiate credits reported on annual affidavit of compliance.
Arkansas	Retain your attendance certificate to substantiate your credits. Also, send a copy to the Arkansas CLE Board.
*California	Complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Retain your attendance certificate to substantiate MCLE credits reported on your California compliance card. For legal specialization credits the Activity Evaluation Form for California MCLE and Certificate of Attendance for California Legal Specialization will be available on the webcast home page. Complete and mail or fax the form to ALI-ABA and retain your certificate for your records.
Colorado	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Submit affidavit to Board, completing section titled "accreditation in another (mandatory CLE) state;" http://www.coloradosupremecourt.com/CLE/cle_home.htm or submit attendance certificate to Board with statement certifying the number of credit hours you received.
Delaware	Approval Pending. Commission is reviewing rules governing online CLE
Florida	Participants must apply directly to state for approval; application at www.floridabar.org . Retain copy of attendance certificate to substantiate credits.
*Georgia	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Limited to 6 credit hours per compliance period.
Idaho	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Participants must apply directly to state for approval; application at www.state.id.us/isb/mcle/mcle.htm ; retain attendance certificate to substantiate credits

State	MCLE Information and Instructions
Illinois	It is the expectation that ALI-ABA programs will be approved retroactively when the Illinois MCLE Board begins such approval.
*Indiana	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Limited to 6 credit hours per 3-year compliance period.
Iowa	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Retain your attendance certificate to attach to your year-end report to the Iowa MCLE Commission. Limited to 6 credit hours per compliance period.
Kansas	To receive credit, you must (1) watch the entire program, (2) answer every on-screen prompt throughout the program, and (3) complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Claiming hours for segments not actually attended could be a violation of Rule 8.4(c) of the Kansas Rules of Professional Conduct for Lawyers. Limited to 5 credit hours per compliance period; maximum of 1 credit hour per program.
*Kentucky	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. A Kentucky Attendance Certification card will be forwarded to you, which you must then submit to the Kentucky Bar Association. Limited to 6 credit hours per compliance; organized group viewings are considered Participatory CLE, therefore no limitation on credits.
*Louisiana	Approval Pending. You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. A Louisiana Course Attendance Form will be forwarded to you to complete & return to ALI-ABA. The Louisiana CLE Board will NOT accept CLE forms directly from registrants. Limited to 4 credit hours per compliance period.
*Maine	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Limited to 5.5 credits hours per compliance period; ½ of your total credit hours per compliance period.
Minnesota	Retain your attendance certificate to substantiate credits reported on annual affidavit.
*Mississippi	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Limited to 3 credit hours per compliance period.
Missouri	Retain your attendance certificate to substantiate credits reported on annual affidavit.
Montana	Retain your attendance certificate to substantiate credits reported annually to the Montana Board of CLE.
* Nevada	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Also, return a copy of your attendance certificate to the Nevada CLE Board.
*New Hampshire	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Retain your attendance certificate to substantiate credits reported on New Hampshire's Annual Compliance Form.
*New Mexico	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Submit self-study certificate available at www.nmmcle.org to Board; retain attendance certificate to substantiate credits. Limited to 5 credit hours per compliance period; Group viewings are considered Participatory CLE, therefore no limitation on credits.
*New York	To receive credit, you must answer the on-screen prompts throughout the program and complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. A personalized New York Attendance Certificate will be e-mailed to you after the program (approximately 2 weeks). Not accredited for lawyers in practice for fewer than two years.
*North Carolina	To receive credit, you must answer the on-screen prompts throughout the program and complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Limited to 4 credit hours per compliance period.
North Dakota	Retain your attendance certificate to substantiate credits reported every three years to the North Dakota CLE Commission.
*Ohio	To receive credit, you must answer the on-screen prompts throughout the program and complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Limited to 6 credit hours per compliance period.
*Oklahoma	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program.

State	MCLE Information and Instructions
*Oregon	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Participants must apply directly to the state for approval; application at http://www.osbar.org/mcle/forms.html Retain copy of your certificate of attendance for your records.
*Pennsylvania	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. The survey must be completed in order for ALI-ABA to report your attendance to the Pennsylvania CLE Board for credit. After you submit your evaluation, a link is provided on the webcast home page to your Attendance Certificate for your records. Limited to 4 credit hours per compliance period. Additional credit hours earned for web casts can NOT be carried over to the next compliance period.
*Rhode Island	To receive credit, you must answer the on-screen prompts throughout the program and complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program.
*South Carolina	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Limited to 4 credit hours per compliance period through participation in webcast seminars, can only receive 1 credit hour per program.
*Tennessee	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program.
*Texas	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. A Texas CLE Course Attendance Form will be forwarded to you to complete & return to ALI-ABA. The Texas CLE Board will NOT accept CLE forms directly from registrants.
*Utah	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Limited to 12 credit hours per 2 year compliance period.
Vermont	Retain your attendance certificate to substantiate credits reported every two years to the Vermont MCLE Board. Limited to 10 credit hours per 2 year compliance period.
Virginia	To receive credit, you must answer the on-screen prompts throughout the program and complete the questionnaire/ affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. A link to the Virginia Attendance Form will be provided for you to submit to the Virginia State Bar.
*Washington	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Participants must apply directly to state for approval; application at www.wsba.org . Retain attendance certificate to substantiate credits.
West Virginia	Return your attendance certificate to the West Virginia MCLE Board. Limited to 1/2 of credits per compliance period through participation in webcast seminars.
*Wisconsin	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Retain your attendance certificate to substantiate credits reported every two years.
Wyoming	You must complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey on the webcast home page when you exit the program. Participants must apply directly to state for approval; application at www.wyomingbar.org/cle/application.html . Retain attendance certificate to substantiate credits
CPE Credits	You must answer all on-screen prompts and complete the questionnaire/affirmation and survey if you are requesting CPE credit.
